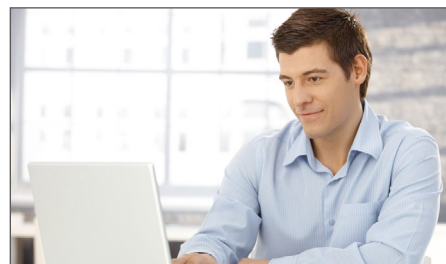


WA Compulsory Professional Development
